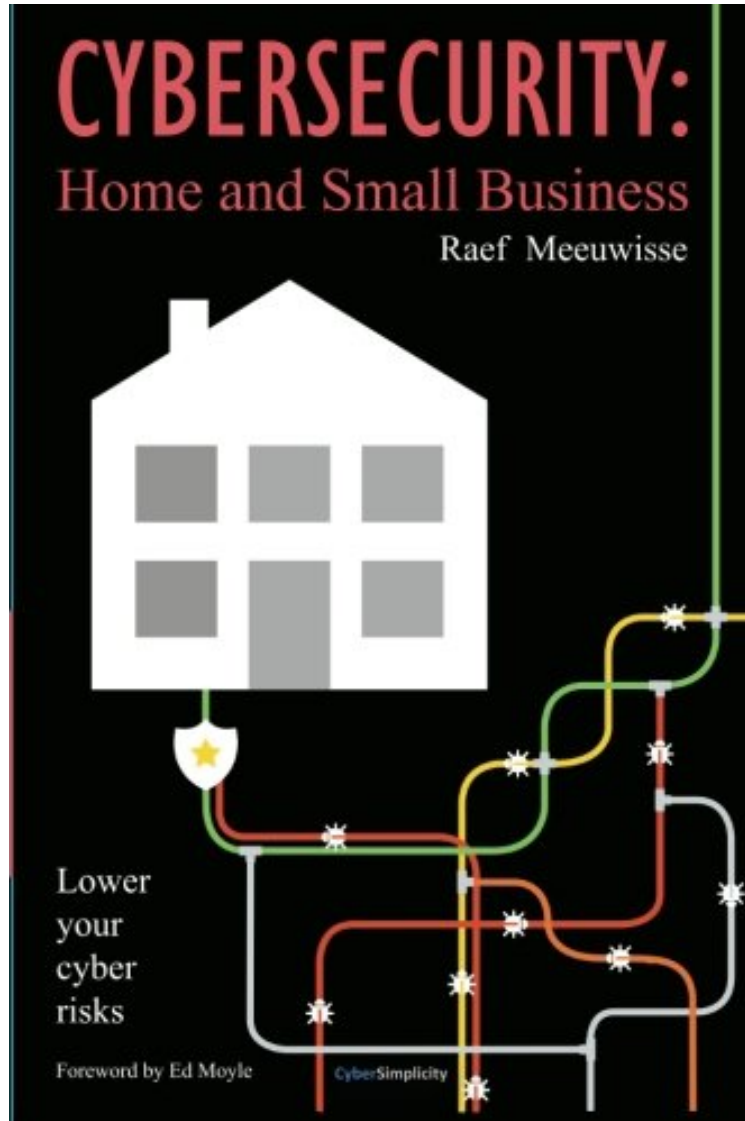

Raef will not try to convince you that his book is the be-all and end-all for information security, but for the home and small business owner, this book will cover the most prevalent risks you are likely to face and provide pragmatic advice to protect yourself; with clear definitions throughout so you do not get lost in technobabble.
