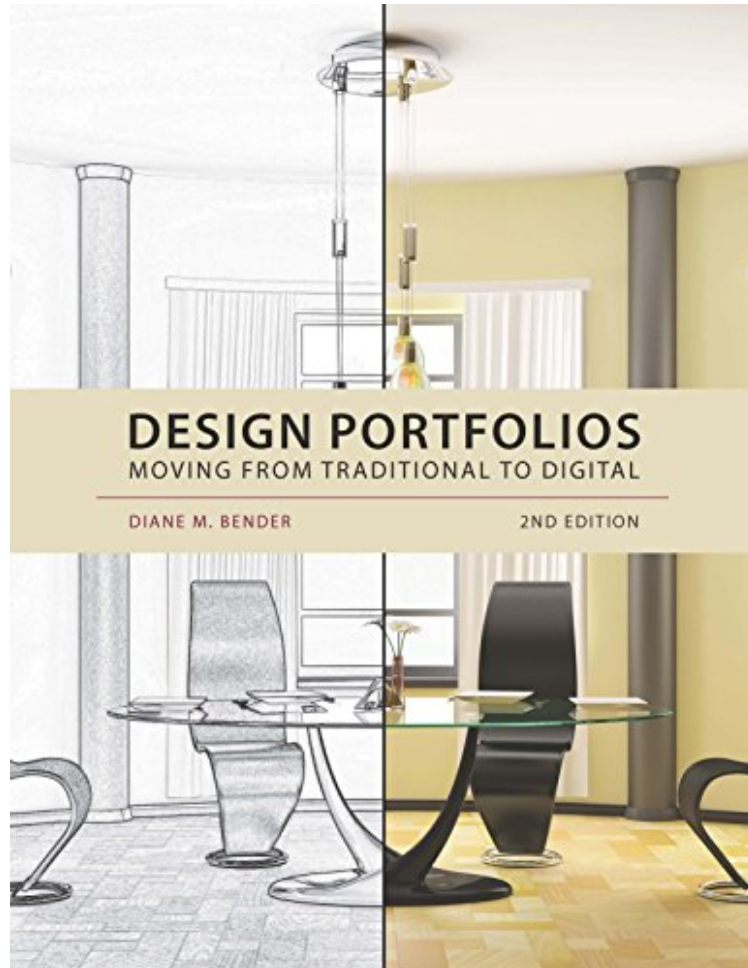


Design Portfolios: Moving from Traditional to Digital
